

How to set your PC to Boot From the CD Drive



Press DEL to enter SETUP, <F8> to Enter Boot Menu 11/07/2003-nVidia-nForce-6A61BM49C-00

## Step One

Turn your PC on. The first screen should give you similar option to the ones above. Press either button.




# Step Two

On the Enter Boot Menu Screen, choose CDROM or similar, (if this option is not available go into Setup).




#### Step Three

In Setup/BIOS use the arrow keys on your keyboard to highlight Advanced BIOS Features and press Enter.



### Step Four

With AMIBIOS highlighted Boot Device Select and hit Enter Key and choose CDROM. (next Phoenix BIOS).




#### Step Five

With Pheonix highlighted First Boot Device and using the PageUp or PageDown keys change it to CDROM.



### Step Six

Press the ESC key to go to the main screen and highlight... Save and Exit Setup.



# Step Seven

Press the Y key and then the Enter Key to finish. Your PC will now reboot.
